For example, upon reaching the site, if you were searching for a GPU, the thing I searched for, you would hover over the “Components and Storage” category which would bring up sub-categories, then you would navigate to the “GPU & Video Graphics Device” where you could choose to either go directly to the page for all of things related to that or go through one more sub-category titled “GPUs/Video Graphics Cards.”

My biggest critique of the purchasing process would likely be that these days the site does offer a lot of stuff, if you do not know exactly what you want, navigation can be a pain often requiring external research into products before beginning the shopping journey. Taking my example from earlier, you would first need to be aware of which category the thing you’re looking for resides in so you do not go randomly clicking around looking for stuff. I know a GPU would be considered a component, but someone completely new to pc building might not know that. There is a search bar to help alleviate this but again, that falls into needing to know what you’re looking for before you even reach the site.

The way I shop, I would definitely buy this product online if the best price for it is offered there, conversely if the best price is offered in a local store I would buy it there instead.

The internet is one of the main ways I shop, and I personally have been using this site since I came across it in 2016 so I definitely without a doubt would use it again.
